The Fall Athletic Recognition Night was held October 23, 2006 as the efforts and accomplishments of 384 student athletes were lauded. Nagel student athletes participated in cheerleading, cross-country, football, and volleyball. Over 170 7th & 8th graders participated in our football program, the highest participation rate in the past five years. The cross-country squads had over 100 athletes, while volleyball & cheerleading continue to provide opportunities for young ladies. The 8th grade Blue football team, led by coach Jim Schaefer, consisted of 44 student athletes, as they prepare to contribute at Anderson next fall. The Blue squad finished the season with a 2-5 record.
